## **FOOD TRUCKS, ENTERTAINMENT, SHOPPING AND MORE AT SAN GABRIEL LUNAR NEW YEAR FESTIVAL SATURDAY**

**SAN GABRIEL, CA** – Food trucks, lion dancers, craft beer, chalk art, vendor booths and more will take over the Mission District this Saturday, Feb. 6 from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m. for the City of San Gabriel’s Second Annual Lunar New Year Festival.

The free festival, which aims to put a modern twist on the traditional new year celebration, will offer live entertainment all day long on the outdoor stage and inside the beautiful Mission Playhouse. The impressive lineup of performers, which concludes with headliner MC Jin, is attached to this release. Festival attendees can also enjoy 14 food trucks and food booths, a craft beer garden with local brews on tap, over 40 vendor booths, arts and crafts, a kids’ zone, chalk art walk, Bboy dance competition and more. There’s something for everyone at this celebration, which kicks off the Year of the Monkey.

Street closures for the event are as follows: Mission Drive from Mission Road to W Broadway and Santa Anita Street from W Broadway to McGroarty Street. Roads will close at 10 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 5 and will reopen on Sunday, Feb. 7 at 7 a.m.

Free parking for the festival will be available at the Mission Playhouse (enter on Broadway), the Park & Ride Lot (Mission Drive and Broadway) and San Gabriel Valley Medical Center (northwest corner of Santa Anita and Broadway). There will also be street parking available.
