CITY OFFERS FREE SUMMER ACTIVITIES FOR KIDS

SAN GABRIEL, CA – It's summer in San Gabriel, and there is no shortage of free and low-cost city-sponsored activities to keep the kids and family entertained.

Summer Fun Recreation Programs started June 6 at Smith Park and Washington Elementary, and kick off on June 13 at Roosevelt Elementary and Vincent Lugo Park. Parents can drop off the kids during the day to enjoy fun activities supervised by city recreation leaders. Free lunch will be available to children 18 years old and younger from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., provided by the San Gabriel Unified School District. Children under six years old must be accompanied by an adult.

Recreation programs run Monday through Friday. Hours are 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Smith Park through Aug. 5, 12-5:30 p.m. through July 1 at Washington Elementary, 12-5:30 p.m. through July 1 and 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. through Aug. 5 at Roosevelt Elementary, and 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. through Aug. 5 at Vincent Lugo Park.

For middle school students, the Community Services Department offers free **Bulldog Sports Camp** at Jefferson Middle School, Monday through Friday 12:30-3:30 p.m. from June 6 to July 8.

For families looking for some evening fun, the new **Parks After Dark** program offers free games, arts and crafts and other activities on Tuesdays at Smith Park and Wednesdays at Vincent Lugo Park at 6 p.m. from June 21 through Aug. 3 (no programs the week of July 4).

In addition to the free summer programs, the Community Services Department offers low-cost **recreation swim** at Smith Park Pool, beginning on June 14. Hours are Wednesday-Saturday 1:00-3:30 p.m. and Tuesday 7-9 p.m. Registration is open for **swim lessons**, which will begin on June 13. Parents can also register their children, grades one through eight, for **Summer Day Camp** at Coolidge Elementary through Aug. 12.
