SAN GABRIEL TO CELEBRATE JULY 4 WITH PARADE AND PICNIC

SAN GABRIEL, CA – The City of San Gabriel will celebrate Independence Day with the annual 4th of July Parade and Kids' Day picnic on Monday, July 4.

Both the parade and the picnic are free to attend and open to the entire community. The parade will begin at 9 a.m. (a new time from last year) at Plaza Park, 428 S Mission Drive, then head north on Mission and east on Broadway to end at Smith Park, 232 W Broadway Ave.

The city will accept parade entries on the day of the parade at 8 a.m. at Plaza Park. Community groups and residents who participate in the parade will be awarded prizes for most patriotic decorations and attire. For more information on parade entries, visit www.sangabrielcity.com/july4.

Following the parade, community members can enjoy the Kids' Day picnic at Smith Park, featuring a free barbecue lunch, entertainment provided by San Gabriel Library, free recreational swim at Smith Park Pool from 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., summer activities including a watermelon eating contest and picnic games, and fun booths and activities sponsored by community organizations. New this year, there will also be a live band on stage playing music for picnic attendees to enjoy.

At the picnic, the city will display the Honor Wall, which includes the names of current and former members of the military that are from San Gabriel.
