

## Veterans Day Tribute and Luncheon



# THE LATIN WAVE

Next May, the Playhouse comes to life in a whole new way – in fact, a whole range of ways. Audiences attending “The Latin Wave” will get to experience theater, film, dance, live music, exhibits and conversations all in one event, not just in the theater, but in and around the building from courtyard to backstage and beyond.

The Latin Wave – subtitled *Exploring Myth, Illusion and Cultural Appropriation* is a unique collaboration between the Mission Playhouse and About Productions. This East LA based theater company has been creating original interdisciplinary performances and educational programs that provoke new perspectives on history, humanity, and culture for over 27 years. Because the company is dedicated to generating new work through collaboration to create artistic and community dialogue, they are an ideal partner for this project. Co-founding Artistic Director’s Theresa Chavez and Rose Portillo were together awarded the *Playwrights’ Arena Lee Melville Award* (2012) for outstanding contributions to the LA Theater Community. In 2013, Chavez won *La Opinion’s Mujeres Destacadas Award* in the category of Arts and Culture.

*The Latin Wave* takes place over a week-long period in and around the Playhouse from May 15th - 21st and through music, film, dance, theater, exhibition and community conversation, explores the portrayal of



Latino people in the media – particularly in Hollywood movies through the ages. The Playhouse, with its rich history, is the perfect venue for the series and will play host to a “site specific” remounting of About Productions 2005 show *They Shoot Mexican’s Don’t They* which tells the story of an East Coast movie director’s plans to shoot a movie of the fabled *Mission Play*. The play includes dance, projection and live music from members of the band Quetzal and, rather than just sit in the theater and watch the action unfold, audiences will get to explore the Playhouse as they move around with the performers from courtyard to lobby, backstage to onstage and other areas in between.

Other aspects of *The Latin Wave* include a silent movie with live accompaniment on our 1925 Wurlitzer organ, an exhibition in the Glass Room Gallery of artifacts from the *Mission Play* and other materials.

Playhouse staff is also looking forward to working with local students to bring to life oral histories as told by some of our older community members. The series will also bring together prominent commentators and academics such as Cathy Gudis, History Professor at UC Riverside, to stimulate community conversations around the portrayal of Latino people in mainstream media.

All in all, there’s plenty to see, hear and do at the *The Latin Wave*, May 15th - 21st, 2017 at the Mission Playhouse. Look out for more details at the Mission Playhouse website [www.missionplayhouse.org](http://www.missionplayhouse.org).



## After School Programs
