



Get Involved: Join a City Commission!

Being a member of a City Commission opens the door to a plethora of opportunities to make a real difference in the community. Commissioners have a chance to voice the first opinion on upcoming projects and issues in the City, and get the first chance to vote on them before they head to the City Council. These are very important positions in our city government – now is your chance to get involved!

The **Civil Service Commission** consists of five members whose responsibility is to hear employee appeals regarding disciplinary action. Meetings are held on an as-needed basis. Civil Service Commissioners must reside in the City of San Gabriel.

The **Community Services Commission** is an advisory board, consisting of five members that provide a communication link between the City Council, Community Services staff, and the community on matters related to community services and leisure-time programs and activities. Regular meetings are held the first Monday of each month from October through June at 7:00 p.m. Community Services Commissioners must reside in the City of San Gabriel.

The **Design Review Commission** is comprised of three members to include representation from design professions such as architecture, landscape architecture, engineering and building design. The Design Review Commission is responsible for reviewing building plans for commercial and residential projects. Meetings are held the fourth Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. There are no residency requirements imposed. ***Representation from design professions such as architecture and engineering is required.**

The **Planning Commission** consists of five members who consider applications for zone changes, subdivisions, variances, development plans and conditional use permits, in addition to other special applications. Further, the Planning Commission makes recommendations to the City Council concerning amendments to the General Plan, land use and zoning standards. Regular meetings are held the second Monday of each month at 6:30 p.m. Planning Commissioners must reside in the City of San Gabriel.
