

## **SAN GABRIEL CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF JANUARY 18, 2005**

The regular meeting of the San Gabriel City Council convened on January 18, 2005 at 7:30 p.m. with Councilmember Cammarano, Vice Mayor Costanzo, Councilmember Gutierrez, Councilmember Mui, Deputy City Attorney Wallin, City Manager Paules and City Clerk Trujillo present. Mayor Baldwin was excused.

Councilmember Gutierrez moved to excuse the absence of Mayor Baldwin; seconded by Councilmember Mui. There being no objections, it was so ordered.

Each year, the City of San Gabriel receives funds through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. Federal regulations require the local entity receiving CDBG funds to hold a public hearing to give the community an opportunity to provide input on the proposed use of the grant. Proposed projects have been identified and a notice of public hearing has been duly published.

Councilmember Gutierrez moved to open the public hearing; seconded by Councilmember Cammarano. There being no objections, it was so ordered.

Councilmember Mui moved to adopt Resolution 05-02; seconded by Councilmember Cammarano. The resolution was approved by a vote on the board of four yes with Mayor Baldwin being absent.

In March of 2001, the Millennium Miles 5-year program was implemented. With Phases I, II & III being successfully completed, it is now time to move ahead with Phase IV. Plans and specifications have been prepared and the project advertised. Fifteen bids were received that are now being presented for Council consideration.

Councilmember Cammarano moved to award Cash Contract 04-08 to the lowest responsible bidder, Sylvia Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$704,134.70 in accordance with their bid; and authorize the execution of the contract documents; seconded by Councilmember Mui. The motion passed by a vote on the board of four yes with Mayor Baldwin being absent.
