7. ORDINANCE 556-C.S. – AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN GABRIEL ADOPTING OVERNIGHT PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON PUBLIC STREETS

At the August 16, 2005 meeting, the subject ordinance was approved on first reading by a vote of 4-1 that prohibits overnight parking on the street from 2-6 a.m. Ordinance 556-C.S. is being presented for adoption on second reading.

Recommended Action: That the City Council adopt Ordinance 556-C.S.

8. ORDINANCE 558-C.S. – AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN GABRIEL SETTING CITY COUNCIL SALARIES

In conjunction with the budget process, staff reviewed the City Council's salary and is recommending a cost of living increase that is provided for by the Government Code and would not be effective until March 20, 2007.

Recommended Action: That the City Council waive further reading and introduce Ordinance No. 558-C.S.
