D. FRAUD, WASTE AND ABUSE HOTLINE

In an effort to continuously update the City's Administrative Policies, the City Manager has worked with the City Attorney's Office to update Administrative Policy #505, "Fraud Waste, and Abuse in the Workplace." As part of this effort, Section 2.4 calls out the creation of a Fraud Hotline. The number designated for the hotline is (626) 308-2807 and will be launched upon City Council's approval.

Recommended Action:

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the creation of a Fraud, Waste, and Abuse hotline.

E. CITY OF SAN GABRIEL LEGISLATIVE PLATFORM 2021 FINAL DRAFT

On February 2, 2021, staff introduced the City of San Gabriel Legislative Platform to the City Council to outline the City's position on legislative, regulatory or policy issues that impact or affect the City. The Platform was created to provide Council and staff with the direction to support or oppose legislation, after Council Consideration. After Council's review and feedback, staff was directed to bring the Platform before the Council again for a final draft to include the City Council's suggestions.

Recommended Action:

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the final draft of the City of San Gabriel Legislative Platform 2021.

A. CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH FIRST TRANSIT FOR DIAL-A-RIDE SERVICE

The City of San Gabriel provides Dial-A-Ride service for City residents age 62 and over and individuals with disabilities. The City contracts with a transit provider, First Transit, to manage and operate the Dial-A-Ride service. At the February 2, 2021 regular meeting, the City Council reviewed the program information and requested that staff return with an extension of the contract with First Transit to allow staff time to review and provide transit options for Council's consideration.

Recommended Action:

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the Amendment to Dial-A-Ride Transportation Services Agreement with First Transit and authorize the City Manager to execute the documents.
