**A. 405 SOUTH DEL MAR AVENUE HOUSING OPTIONS**


The presentation was made by City Manager Lazzaretto, Economic Development Manager Domenica Megerdichian, and Related Companies development team representatives Meea Kang, Rose Olson, and Jennifer Ing-aram.

Discussion included unit sizes; parking space allotment; site challenges that limit project components; tax credit program in relation to type of units; wrap-around services; pros and cons of types of units; elevator inclusion for three stories or seniors; underground parking being cost-prohibitive; mixing or separating family and senior units; benefits of apartment units rather than homes for sale; partnering with community organizations for services; and community outreach messaging.
