



ILLICIT DISCHARGE STORMWATER POLLUTION

Please help keep the City of San Gabriel safe and clean by following the instructions below.

"No person shall place, dump, litter, accumulate, maintain, discharge, or cause to enter into the MS4 any pollutant or any foreign object such as batteries, tires, waste receptacles, yard debris, refuse, rubbish, food waste, chemicals, animal waste or oil cans - which are also considered illicit discharges." (SGMC Chapter 53.00)



What is a Violation?

Any of the following can be a violation:

- Food, oils, & grease
- Trash & Litter
- Mop water or washing outside without containment
- Any chemicals
- Runoff from construction sites or washing concrete pumps
- Animal waste

Restaurants

- Wash mats and floors into kitchen drain & not outside
- Pour grease and oil into approved container

Auto Shops & Mechanics

- Dispose of motor oil and fluids properly
- Do not wash chemicals off property

Best Management Practices

- Do not dump any items outside the business
- Dispose of oils and grease properly in a container without spilling
- Keep container lid closed
- Have secondary containment around the container
- Keep sand, kitty litter, or an absorbent nearby for spills
- Train staff on how to clean spills immediately
- Do not dump dirty mop water outside
- Dispose of chemicals, paint, and oil by calling 1 (888) CLEAN LA
